## RECOMMENDED MOTION(S) OR ACTION(S):

To adopt a Resolution allowing the Southern Manatee Fire Rescue District to write-off uncollectible accounts receivable, in the amount of \$450.00.

## REPORT:

In accordance with Florida Statutes 17.20, 17.041 and Chapter 69I-71 of the Florida Administrative Code, the District is responsible to enforce collections of their receivables and to submit uncollectible accounts to be written-off annually to the Board of Fire Commissioners.

This request for write-off represents remaining amounts due directly from multiple false fire alarm responses made by the District to a business during the period from August 1, 2013 through September 30, 2014.

## **RESOLUTION 2014 - 09**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS OF THE SOUTHERN MANATEE FIRE & RESCUE DISTRICT OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA.

#### Re: STATEMENT OF UNCOLLECTIBLE ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE

WHEREAS, thirty-eight (38) percent of the Fire Responses each year are related to malfunctions, accidental activations, and malicious activations of Fire Alarm Systems which unnecessary utilize a significant number of fire apparatus and firefighters; and

WHEREAS, the Southern Manatee Fire Rescue District has responded to multiple fire alarms to businesses whose accounts received service between August 1, 2013 through September 30, 2014; and

WHEREAS, these accounts have been deemed as uncollectible for reasons of either going out of business, change in ownership, or alarm system repaired.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Fire Commissioners, acting as the governing body of the Southern Manatee Fire Rescue District of Manatee County, Florida, in a public meeting assembled:

1. Southern Manatee Fire Rescue District has provided service in the amount of \$450.00 that has been determined to be uncollectible.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
