

## ADMINISTRATIVE MEMORANDUM

**RE:** Surplus Fixed Assets April 8, 2015

The District recently placed in service two (2) brand new 2015 Class A Fire Engines. These two (2) new Fire Engines will replace E6 (1999 Pierce Dash) and E7 (2001 Pierce Dash).

Our recommendation is to sell E6 to Brindle Mountain and to donate E7 to the Duette Fire Rescue District. Attached is a letter from Duette Fire Chief Jim Leonard requesting the donation of E7.

According to phone conversations with Brindle Mountain, they would give us \$18,000 to \$23,000 for E6. Brindle Mountain is scheduled to come down to Manatee County in April to assess E6.

This past year two local Fire Districts donated their surplus Engines to Manatee Technical College Fire Academy. Below are the summary totals for these items:
