During the month of January the county's training officers finalized the curriculum for the countywide Swift Assist Victim Extraction (S.A.V.E.) team trainings. This training is for Law, Fire and EMS personnel in preparation for an active shooter event response. This training addresses potential media concerns and allows for the rapid choreographed rescue of victims, but is only implemented when the perpetrators are killed, captured or contained. Southern Manatee is the first fire or EMS department to teach this training, with other departments starting in a week or two later. Also during the month of January, the Field Training Officer's continue to teach their personnel practical hands-on training at the old Manatee Technical Institute building. The availability of this building allows for hands on training utilizing powered hand tools, and the review of specialized skills. This building is only available for a limited amount of time. Lastly, the crews continue working on their EMT, Fire and Inspector recertification's utilizing Target Solutions.
